Hello Hedgehogs and Parents!

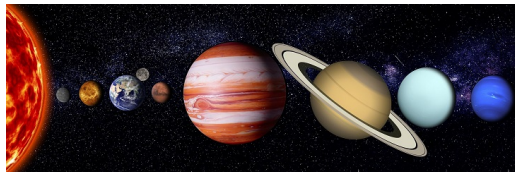
HAPPY NEW YEAR!
