OUR AIM to educate drivers to keep roads safer for carriage drivers, horse riders, cyclists and pedestrians. The Highway Code states:

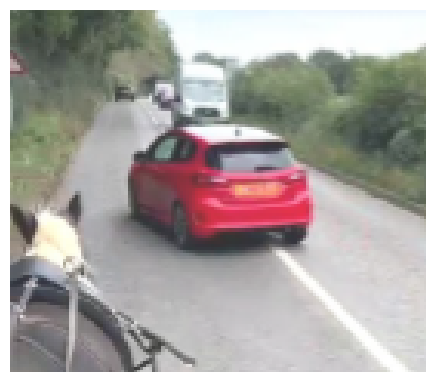


Slow down, maximum speed of 10 mph.
